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SourceCF[®] Pediatric Drops, an oral multivitamin liquid, is specifically formulated to meet the needs of infants and children with cystic fibrosis and those who have difficulty absorbing fat-soluble vitamins and nutrients. **SourceCF[®] Pediatric Drops** provide a water-miscible formulation of the fat-soluble vitamins A, D, E, and K to improve absorption while also providing vitamins C & B, biotin and zinc.

SourceCF[®] Pediatric Drops were formulated to meet or exceed the daily supplemental vitamin recommendations established by the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation as reported in their Nutrition Consensus Statement published in the *Journal of Gastroenterology and Nutrition*, September 2002.

SourceCF[®] Pediatric Drops also contain increased levels of vitamins D and K to support bone health.

USAGE

For nutritional supplementation in individuals with diets deficient in fat-soluble vitamins or difficulty in absorbing fat-soluble vitamins as may occur in cystic fibrosis.† For use solely under medical supervision.

PHARMACOLOGY

Deficiencies of one or more of the fat-soluble vitamins (A, D, E & K) may occur in individuals with insufficient intake of these vitamins or who have difficulty in absorbing fats from their diets.

CONTRAINDICATIONS

Do not take this product if you have a known sensitivity or allergy to any of the components.

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION

Age Birth to 12 months ... 1 ml daily
One year through 3 years ... 2 ml daily
or as directed by physician. **Shake contents before dispensing.** Best taken with meals and supplemental pancreatic enzymes.

PRECAUTIONS

General - Safety sealed for your protection. DO NOT use if seal is broken. Keep this and all medication out of reach of children.

Anticoagulant Therapy - Vitamin K interferes with actions of anticoagulant drugs. Persons taking anticoagulants should consult their physician before taking **SourceCF[®] Pediatric Drops**.

HOW SUPPLIED

Bottles of 60 ml with dropper included. Dispensed in tight, light-resistant containers as defined in the USP/NF. Store at room temperature, between 59°F and 86°F (15°C and 30°C), in a dry place.
